CONFESSION AND ABSOLUTION

- L: Hosanna! Hosanna in the highest!
- C: Blessed is He who comes in the name of the Lord. Hosanna to the Son of David.
- L: On this day when we remember Jesus' entry into Jerusalem as King and Savior, we join with the inhabitants of Jerusalem, with loud shouts of hosanna and praise. The King is coming and we celebrate. But we also inwardly examine ourselves. As we come before the throne of our King, we pray that God would search our hearts and minds that we may

receive His Word, share in His Spirit, and be renewed in our relationships with Him and with one another.

We take a moment of silence for personal prayers of confession.

- L: Lord Jesus, the King of kings and Lord of lords, hear us as we pray:
- C: Lord, You reign over all things and yet humbled Yourself for our salvation. We confess that our rebellion against You in thought, word, and deed is the reason why You entered into this world. It is why You passed through the gates of Jerusalem on Palm Sunday and why You laid down Your life upon Calvary's cross on Good Friday—to forgive our sins, to redeem our lives, and to cancel the debt we owe to God. With hearts that are humble and lives that are grateful, help us to receive Your grace and bow before You in worship. Amen.
- L: Almighty God, our heavenly Father, shows His mercy to us in the sending of His only Son, the King of kings and Lord of lords. The One who entered into Jerusalem on Palm Sunday was handed over to death upon the cross so that we may be reconciled to the Father and granted His remission, full and free. In Him is forgiveness of sins, life, and salvation. As a called and ordained servant of Christ, I therefore forgive you all your sins in the name of the Father and of the Son and of the Holy Spirit.
- C: Amen! Rejoice in the Lord always. The joy of the Lord is our strength!

Whoever abides in me and I in him, he it is that bears much fruit, for apart from me you can do nothing. ⁶ If anyone does not abide in me he is thrown away like a branch and withers; and the branches are gathered, thrown into the fire, and burned. ⁷ If you abide in me, and my words abide in you, ask whatever you wish, and it will be done for you. 8 By this my Father is glorified, that you bear much fruit and so prove to be my disciples. 9 As the Father has loved me, so have I loved you. Abide in my love. ¹⁰ If you keep my commandments, you will abide in my love, just as I have kept my Father's commandments and abide in his love. 11 These things I have spoken to you, that my joy may be in you, and that your joy may be full.
